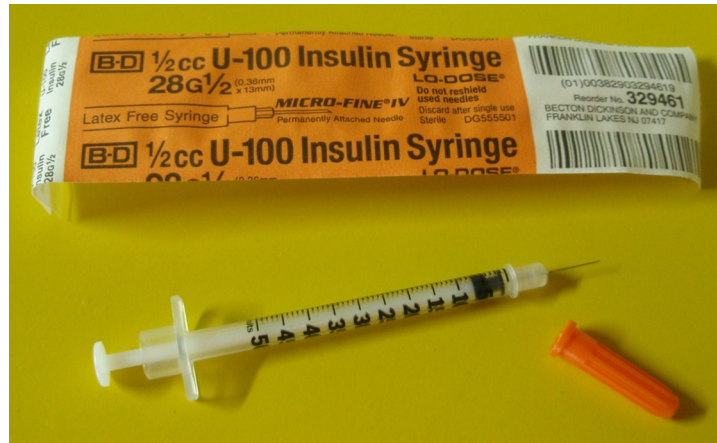


1cc Insulin Syringe



What are they used for?

Injecting drugs and medications.

Practice:

The 1cc insulin syringe is the least damaging to the veins and causes the least amount of bruising.

How they are used:

Insulin syringes are made for one-time, one-person use only. After cooking drugs in a clean cooker, with sterile water, use a clean filter to draw liquid into the syringe. Be sure to clean skin with an alcohol swab before injecting. Tourniquets/ties are optional, but can be helpful.

Risks:

Sharing needles is the easiest way to get HIV or Hep C!

Never share needles!
